5. Ash and Zue's phone scene steals the show. Did it deliver the spice? Do you root for them despite the rules, or was it too risky?

Rescue Mission and Demonic Fury

Team arrives and storms the compound; Val unleashes his demon; sacrifices mount as loyalties fracture.

1. Ash demonstrates a lot of loyalty toward Val. He even talks Kyle into helping. Why do you think that is?
2. Devin and Amani's fight scene and Claire's tether sacrifice emphasize sisterhood. How does it uplift?
3. The arena battle is explosive. What sacrifice stood out as most heroic?
4. What role did the amulet play in the endgame? What do you think Amani's destiny actually was?
5. Val's demonic rampage tests redemption. Was Amani the sole player in pulling him back?
6. Ash carries Azeem and makes a life-altering decision on his behalf via Luxien. Does this lay the ground for a budding bromance or a source of tension?
7. Was Amani's "death" a gut-punch or predictable?
8. Who or what was the real villain in this book?

Whole-Book Discussion Questions

1. Fated mates and reincarnation: Realistic or fantasy fuel? A favorite trope, or do you prefer slow burns?
2. Demon spice: Would a dark side like Val's turn you on as it did for Amani? Why do you think we love antiheroes?
3. What is your favorite fierce heroine moment?
4. Gray almost always leaves unanswered questions at the end of her books. Is it frustrating or enticing?
5. Romance heat: Steamiest scene and why it worked?
6. This book has a lot of action. What was your favorite action scene?
7. Do the end-of-days stakes and cliffhangers make you want to read more of this series?

8. Do the diverse cast and global settings in Gray's books make them more enjoyable?
9. What are your predictions for the next books? What love stories do you see developing? What hints were given about the end-of-days?
10. Is sacrifice for love worth it?
11. Who was your favorite character?
